

What to Bring

Student rooms vary in size. They may be singles, doubles, triples, or quads. Windows usually have blinds or shades. Each student is assigned a bed, mattress, closet, or hanging space for clothes, desk, desk chair, desk lamp, chest of drawers, and wall mirror.

Boarders may personalize their rooms with carpets or rugs and curtains. However, fire codes do not permit wall coverings such as tapestries, flags, banners, or pennants. Thumbtacks, staples, or scotch tape may not be put on any wall.

Below are a few suggestions of specific items students should consider bringing—and restrictions on what they may not bring—to their Lawrenceville House. Families should feel free to contact their student's Housemaster with any questions.

The School strongly recommends that each student label his/her belongings, particularly electronic devices like calculators, iPods, etc.

What to Bring

Appliances:

Alarm clock
desk lamp
fan
flashlight
personal listening devices

Note: Students may only bring electrical cords that are U.L.-tested surge protected devices with a built-in circuit breaker that trips when the power line becomes overloaded.

Bedding:

bath towels (2-4) bedspread or quilt (1) blanket (1)
pillow cases (4)
pillows (2)
sheets (2 sets that will fit 80" long x 39" wide extra-long twin mattress)
wash cloths (2)

Clothes & Shoes:

athletic socks (10+ pairs) bathrobe
belts
dress pants
special skirt/dress
dress shoes (min. 1 pair)
jackets (casual and dress) jeans
sneakers (2 pairs)

sweaters
sweatpants
sweatshirts
swim suit
t-shirts
turtlenecks
underwear
winter coat
hat
gloves
boots

Note: The amount of clothing a student should bring will depend on how often he/she intends to do laundry. Weekly laundry service can be arranged, but community washers and dryers are also available.

Miscellaneous:

athletic equipment (as appropriate)
batteries
bike (along with a helmet and lock)
cups/mugs
small wastebasket
book case
(3'h x 2'w x 1'd)
an ethernet cable (appx. 15 feet)

The "System Restore" CDs that came with your computer.

Note: Only Fifth Formers may bring a television and/or a small refrigerator.

What *NOT* to Bring

candles
incense
halogen lamps
electric heaters
electric grills
air conditioners
heat-producing appliances (including coffee makers,
microwave ovens, toasters
toaster ovens, hot plates,
and irons)
ironing boards
clip-on lamps
string/tube lights.
